 Feast of Unleavened Bread "Chag Ha Matzot" 	Exodus 12:17 Leviticus 23:6 Deuteronomy 16	15 th of Nisan (1 st Month)	On way out of Egypt, no leaven in the bread.
3. Feast of First Fruits "Chag Ha Bikkuim"	Leviticus 23:11 Deuteronomy 16	"Day after the Sabbath"	To 'Celebrate' once they get to the 'Promised Land'
4. Feast of Weeks "Shavuot" "Pentecost"	Leviticus 23: 15-16 Deuteronomy 16:9	"Count" 7 Sabbaths or "count 50 days" from First Fruits	Celebrate the Wheat Harvest A Thanksgiving Feast
5. Feast of Trumpets "Rosh Hashana"	Leviticus 23: 24 Deuteronomy 16:9	1 st of Tishri (7 th Month)	Call to Judgment
6. Day of Atonement "Yom Kippor"	Leviticus 23: 26	10 th of Tishri (7 th Month)	Atonement for Sins
7. Feast of Tabernacles "Sukkot"	Leviticus 23: 34 Deuteronomy 16:13	15 th of Tishri (7 th Month)	A Thanksgiving Feast
