Passover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus is God's Passover Lamb - Exodus 12, Leviticus 23, Mark 14:12, Luke 22:1 - 1 Peter 1: 19 – Jesus is a “lamb” - 1 Cor. 5:7 – Paul's description of Jesus <p>Twilight? – Exodus 12: 5-6: “between the settings of the sun”</p> <p>Jesus death? The 9th hour – Mark 15: 33-34</p>
Unleavened Bread	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus is the “bread of life” - John 6:35 - Leaven is a picture of sin - Jesus is the “Unleavened bread” of the world
First Fruits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus is God's “first fruit” offering for the resurrection to come - Paul confirms: 1 Corinthians 15:20
<i>God says “count seven weeks” on the “50th day”</i>	
Feast of Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wheat harvest - Greek is <i>Pentecost</i> - Acts 2:1 - the holiday that the Holy Spirit is given is Feast of Weeks

Feast of Trumpets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We are waiting for Jesus return - His return is announced with Trumpets <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Matt. 24: 30-31, 1 Cor. 15:52 - The trumpet blast is the call to judgment for all nations - the next holiday atones for those in Jesus
Day of Atonement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus is God's atoning sacrifice - Romans 3:25
Feast of Tabernacles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - celebrate the harvest provided by God's blessing - emphasis on “living water” - Jesus attends the Feast of Tabernacles: John 7 - Jesus announces that he is the “living water”
