Life 42BC-37AD Reign 14AD-37AD	Tiberius		Jesus Ministry Jesus Crucifixion
Life 12AD-41AD Reign 37AD-41AD	Caligula		According to historian Josephus, he attempted to erect a statue of himself as a 'god' in the Jerusalem Temple but was opposed by a group of Pharisees.
Life 10BC-54 Reign 41AD-54AD	Claudius	Named: <i>Tiberius Claudius Caesar Augustus Germanicus</i> Poisoned	Expelled Jews from Rome. <i>Acts 18:2</i>
Life 37AD-68AD Reign 54AD-68AD	Nero	Named: <i>Nero Claudius Caesar Augustus Germanicus</i>	Emperor when Paul wrote his letter to the Romans.
